DO WELL IN SCHOOL



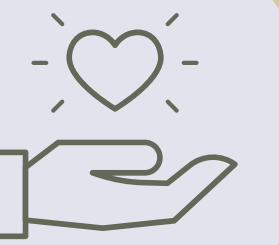
- Use free campus tutoring services.

DISCOVER SUPPORT SERVICES.



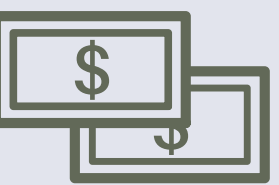
- Use the many support services available on campus—it's their job to help you!
